A woman finds healing by touching Jesus' cloak, and a girl is restored to life when he takes her by the hand. In both cases, a societal boundary is crossed. In Jesus' time the hemorrhaging woman was considered ritually unclean, polluting others by her touch, and anyone who touched a corpse also became unclean. In Mark's gospel Jesus breaks down barriers, from his first meal at a tax collector's house to his last breath on the cross as the temple curtain is torn in two. We dare to reach for and touch Jesus in our "uncleanness" and to live as a community that defines no one as an outsider.

And a large crowd followed him and were pushing up against Jesus. There was a woman who had been sick for twelve years. She had seen many doctors and tried many treatments, and had spent all the money that she had; and she was no better, but instead got worse. She had heard about Jesus, and came up behind him in the crowd and touched his cloak. She said, "If I but

touch his clothes, I will be made well.” Immediately, she was well. Immediately aware that his power had gone, Jesus turned about in the crowd and said, “Who touched my clothes?”³¹ And his disciples said to him, “You see the crowd around you; how can you say, ‘Who touched me?’” He looked all around to see who had done it. But the woman, knowing what had happened to her, came in fear and trembling, fell down before him, and told him the whole truth. He said to her, “Daughter, your faith has made you well; go in peace, and be healed of your disease.”
